






WHAT IS THE CONCURRENT PROGRAM?

- **▼ STUDENTS CAN OBTAIN COLLEGE CREDIT FROM SUSSEX COUNTY COMMUNITY COLLEGE, RUTGERS UNIVERSITY AND NJIT WHILE IN HIGH SCHOOL.**
- ✓ IN THIS PROGRAM, A CERTIFIED HIGH SCHOOL TEACHER WITH A MASTER'S DEGREE IN THE SPECIFIED FIELD IS GIVEN ADJUNCT STATUS BY THE COLLEGE.
- THE COLLEGE CURRICULUM IS TAUGHT AT SUSSEX TECH AS PART OF THE STUDENT'S REGULAR SCHEDULE. THE CURRICULUM ALSO INCLUDES THOSE ELEMENTS NECESSARY TO MEET THE HIGH SCHOOL CORE COURSE PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENTS.
- ✓ ALL SO REFERRED TO AS "DUAL ENROLLMENT".

CONCURRENT VS. AP CREDIT

	CONCURRENT CREDIT	AP CREDIT
DESCRIPTION	Dual enrollment with college earning credit for both college and high school	Passing exam to prove mastery level of college curriculum
COST	\$175 for 3 credit course at SCC \$234 for 4 credit course at SCC \$150/credit for NJIT	\$97/exam for 2022-23 school year
TRANSFER CREDIT	Earn credit on college transcript typically transfer to most institutions as per each college guidelines	Usually a score of 3 or higher to earn credit. Some colleges more restrictive and require 4 or 5 to earn credit.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. MUST BE A JUNIOR OR SENIOR.
- 2.STUDENTS MUST HAVE A 3.0 CUMULATIVE AVERAGE [AT THE END OF THEIR SOPHOMORE YEAR FOR ELIGIBLE JUNIORS AND AT THE END OF JUNIOR YEAR FOR ELIGIBLE SENIORS].
- 3.STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN A 3.0(B(86%)CUMULATIVE AVERAGE TO CONTINUE IN THE CONCURRENT PROGRAM EACH YEAR.
- 4.STUDENTS MUST PASS THE COLLEGE ACCUPLACER
 TESTS OR BE ELIGIBLE TO WAIVE TEST WHICH WILL BE
 GIVEN IN APRIL

PLACEMENT TEST -ACCUPLACER TEST

To be placed into <u>English</u>, <u>History</u>, and <u>Engineering</u> concurrent courses at Sussex Tech, students must earn a proficient score utilizing any of the following formats:

- WritePlacer 6 or greater
- WritePlacer 5 AND Reading 250 or greater
- WritePlacer 5 AND Writing 250 or greater
- WritePlacer 4 or below AND Reading 250 or greater AND Writing 250 or greater

PLACEMENT TEST - ACCUPLACER TEST

- TO BE PLACED INTO **STATISTICS**
 - QRAS(ALGEBRA) OUTSIDE CALCULATOR IS NOT ALLOWED PROVIDED ONLY WHEN THE TEST DEEMS IT NECESSARY
 - PROFICIENT SCORE 262
- TO BE PLACED INTO BIOLOGY, PRECALCULUS, CALCULUS AND PHYSICS I & II
 - COLLEGE LEVEL MATH(CLM) OUTSIDE CALCULATOR IS NOT ALLOWED - PROVIDED ONLY WHEN THE TEST DEEMS IT NECESSARY
 - PROFICIENT SCORES FOR PRECALCULUS 255 OR HIGHER
 - PROFICIENT SCORE FOR CALCULUS 270

HOW TO WAIVE ACCUPLACER

1. MUST HAVE 3.7 GPA OR HIGHER	1. MUST HAVE 3.7 GPA OR HIGHER
2. MUST BE ENROLLED IN ENGLISH HONORS WITH MINIMUM GRADE OF 90% OR ENGLISH CP WITH MINIMUM GRADE OF 95%	2. MUST HAVE PASSED ALGEBRA 1 CP WITH MINIMUM GRADE OF 90% OR BE CURRENTLY IN ALGEBRA 2 CP/HONORS WITH MINIMUM GRADE OF 90%

COLLEGE LEVEL MATH TEST FOR BIOLOGY or PRECALCULUS or CALCULUS or ENGINEERING PHYSICS CANNOT BE WAIVED

MID-YEAR EVALUATIONS

- STUDENTS ENROLLED IN CONCURRENT COURSES WILL BE EVALUATED MID YEAR.
- STUDENTS MUST MAINTAIN A C(74) AVERAGE OR HIGHER IN ENGLISH TO CONTINUE IN THE ENGLISH CONCURRENT COURSE.
- STUDENTS WITH A 73 OR LOWER WILL BE DROPPED FROM THE COURSE AND MOVED TO A LOWER ENGLISH CLASS WHICH COULD RESULT IN A BROADER SCHEDULE CHANGE.
- CONCURRENT COURSES ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE TO COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES WITH A 'D' AVERAGE.
- *** MANY SCHOOLS ARE NOW ASKING FOR MINIMUM OF B+(90)**




CREDIT TRANSFERABILITY

1. Gather All Documents

Request College transcript from SCCC, NJIT or Rutgers. Keep an unofficial copy of transcripts(know your username/password to log in)

- 2. Review college-specific paperwork required
 Often these might be documents that are
 required to be completed by your counselor/case
 manager in spring of senior year. May have separate
 deadlines.
- 3. Review njtransfer.org



REQUIRED MATERIAL REMEMBER

APPLYING TO SCCC

- 1. Fill out the online application form must include social security number
- 2. For Admission Status choose Concurrent Enrollment Program from the drop down menu
- 3. Admission fee is waived
- 4. Submit the application
- 5. A "no reply" email will be sent to the candidate
- 6. A student ID number will be issued to the student within the week, with password for SCCC student email as well as billing portal access.
 - ** Please email Ms. Varkey your student ID number as confirmation that you have completed the application**



Questions

1. Do I have to apply again if I already applied as a "Jump Start" student?

Ans. No, please still email me your SCCC ID # as confirmation.

2. Can I take courses as both a concurrent and jump start student?

Ans. Yes.

3. How do I know which school accept concurrent (dual enrollment) credit?

Ans. Varies by college. Typically have a minimum grade requirement and max number of credits.



Questions

4. When is billing due?

Ans. Billing is due typically in September and/or January.

5. How can payments be made?

Ans. Parents/students can make payments through the cashnetportal, directly to SCCC via check/moneyorder/cash.**Rutgers & NJIT payments will be paid directly to Sussex Tech**

6. Are concurrent students eligible for scholarships? Ans. Concurrent students are not eligible for scholarships(NJStars...etc)



Questions

7. How will I let colleges know I am taking concurrent courses?

Ans. During the college application process students must request to have their college transcript sent to college/university they are applying to. Once students choose a final college, a request must also be sent for final spring grades of their senior year grades to also be sent.
